# A message from THE INTERIM GENERAL MANAGER

As we reflect on the past year, it has been a privilege to witness the profound impact your generosity has made on people around the world.

The impact you are having is made up of many little moments - moments where you have brought relief, delight and hope.

One such moment was recently seen in the remote Angolan community of Mukwando. After a four-year absence, a team conducted evangelism and outreach in a community almost impossible to reach by road. The excitement and joy expressed on our arrival was palpable. It is because of you that moments like these are possible!

I want to also say a particular thank you for your generosity in providing the funds required to restore an existing GA8 aircraft in Arnhem Land.

This aircraft is being used day in and day out to deliver moments of hope - like rescuing women and children in situations involving domestic violence or transporting over 30 secondary school students from six homelands to school each week.

Last year we had our biggest *Fuel for Father's Day* campaign so far, with 549 churches partnering with us to "fill 6000 jerry cans". This remarkable collective achievement is yours to celebrate. These jerrycans are already at work fuelling life-saving flights.

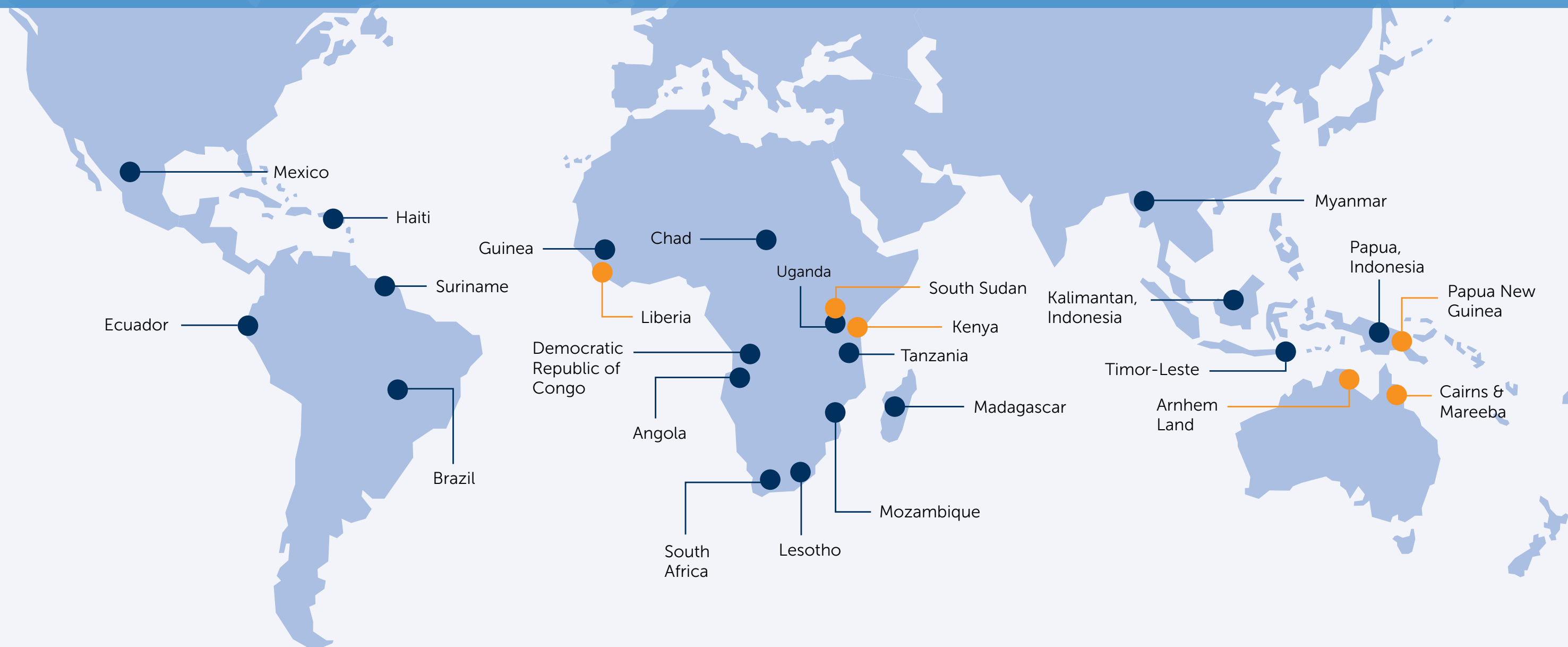

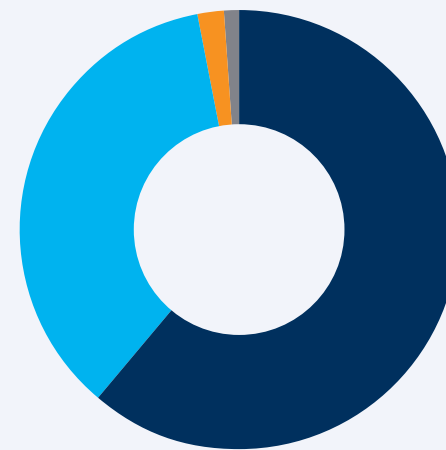

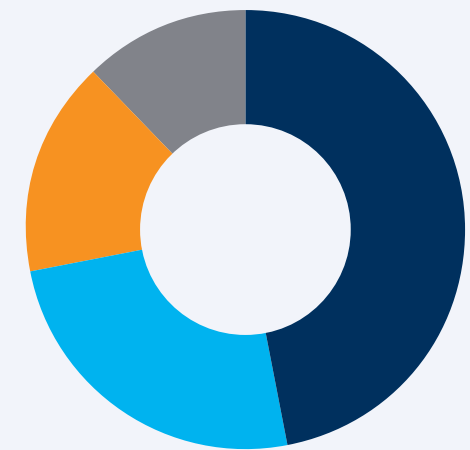
