Who is MAF?

Mission Aviation Fellowship (MAF) is a Christian organisation that provides aviation services for people living in remote areas around the world.

For over 75 years, MAF has been serving isolated people by using aircraft to bring in the essentials of life as well as medical care, emergency food, and Christian hope.

Our purpose is to deliver practical and spiritual care to people in places of deepest human need. Every six minutes, a MAF plane takes off or lands somewhere in the world. These flights enable crucial work by many aid and development agencies, missions, local churches and other national groups. MAF is serving the Church and communities in remote areas where flying is not a luxury, but a lifeline.

What we do at MAF?

Mountains. Jungles. Swamps. Unrest. No roads. We overcome these barriers to bring hope to the isolated.



AID & DEVELOPMENT

In many isolated areas of the world, the fight for survival can be all consuming. Having access to reliable food, clean water and adequate shelter is a daily struggle.



MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Isolation is often responsible for turning the most common medical complication into a life-threatening illness.





DISASTER RELIEF

Isolation can often be the cause of oppression, generally related to a lack of access to education, supportive infrastructure and community development.



CHRISTIAN MISSION

Evangelical Work: As the apostle Paul puts it, "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!" (Rom 10:15). For over 75 years, thousands of those beautiful feet have stepped on and off MAF aircraft in remote corners of the world.



How will my contributions help?

Millions of people cannot access basic medical care, clean water, schools or receive the Good News of God's love, simply because it's too dangerous or time-consuming to reach them.

Aid and development: MAF helps improve living conditions and enables thousands of families to develop safe, healthy, and productive communities. We work with organisations like World Vision, Save the Children, Samaritans Purse, Habitat for Humanity, YWAM, Unicef and many, many others.

Medical Assistance: Thousands are saved each year as MAF speeds patients to hospital, turning days of ground travel into mere minutes. Even more are saved as MAF transports doctors, nurses and medicines to patients in minutes instead of days or weeks. Epidemics are prevented with vaccines and medical personnel transported by MAF.

Disaster Relief: Put simply, the barriers created by natural disasters can be overcome by MAF. MAF aircraft have played critical roles following the Boxing Day Tsunami in Indonesia, Hurricane Felix in Nicaragua, the 2010 earthquake in Haiti, Typhoon Haiyan in the Philippines and the 2015 earthquake in Nepal.


What is Workplace Giving?
